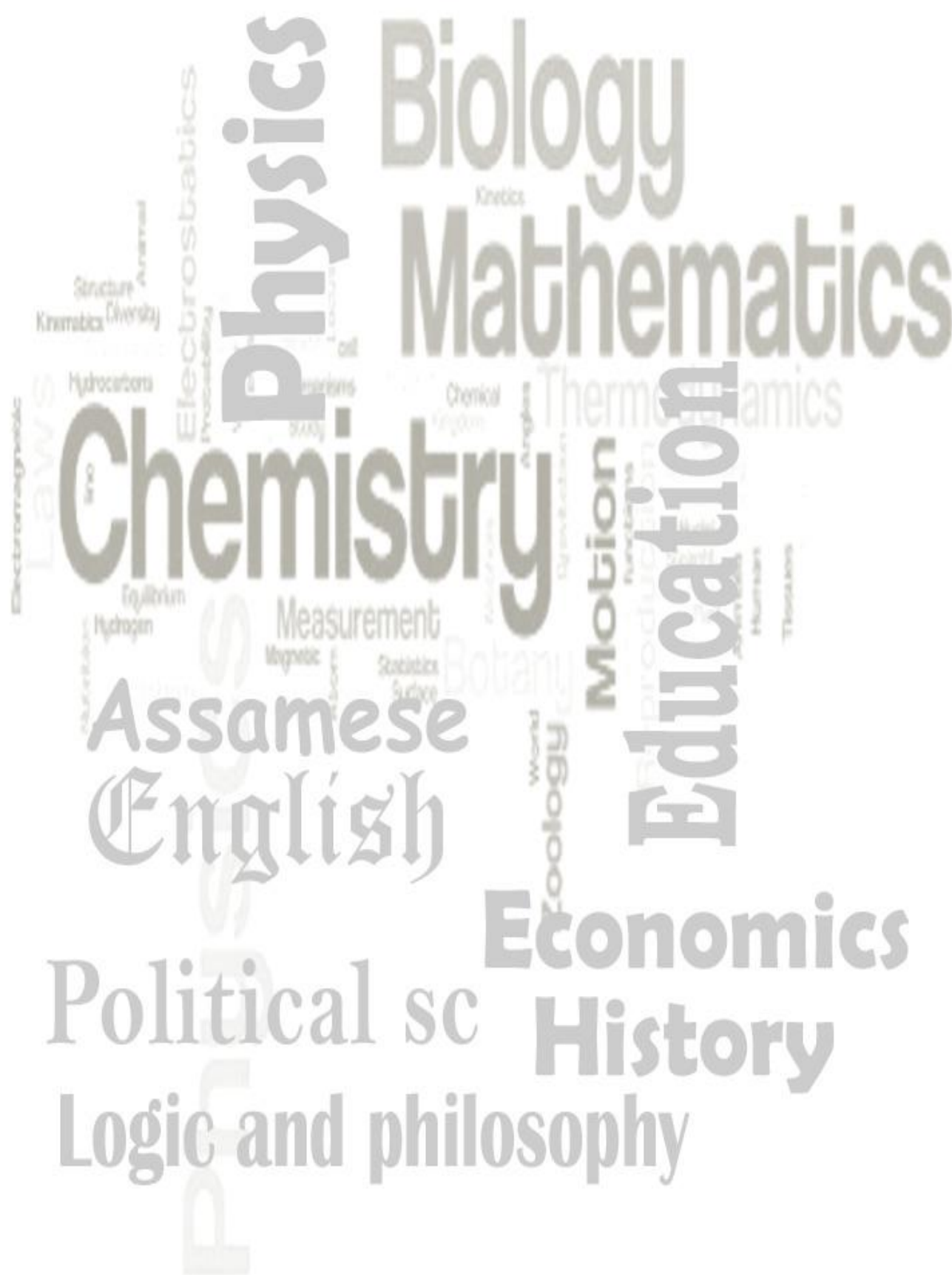

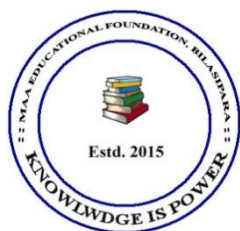

PROGRAMMES OF STUDY

N.H. Memorial Academy imparts education at Higher Secondary (10+2) level both Science and Arts Stream and Under Assam Higher Secondary Education

Council. This year we also have an approved Study Centre for accommodation of Teacher Trainees for D.El.Ed. (ODL mode) Course Under SCERT, Assam and used by Basic Training Centre, Golakganj

The duration of the HS course is 2 (two) years. The course is divided into two parts i.e. HS First Year and HS Final Year. At the end of the First Year, students will have to appear in the Higher Secondary First Year Final Examination conducted by AHSEC. Only those students who pass out this examination become eligible for promotion to Higher Secondary Second Year classes.

On being promoted, a student shall have to take admission in HS Second/ Final Year classes. At the end of the session he/she will have to appear in the Higher Secondary Final Examination conducted by AHSEC.

PATTERN OF EXAMINATION :

H.S. First Year Examination :

1. **English:** one paper of 100 marks.
2. **MIL/Alt. English:** one paper of 100 marks.
- 3 **Elective subjects (four):** 100 marks each $\times 4 = 400$ marks. (In case of subjects having practical parts 70 marks will be allocated to the Theory part and the rest 30 will be allocated to the practical part or the marks division of theory and practical part will be as indicated in the syllabus of concerned subject.) However, the subject in which lowest mark is obtained will be the 4th elective subject and the marks of the 4th subject is not included in the total marks. So, total marks for final exam is 500
4. Environmental Education: 50 marks. (Only in Grade)

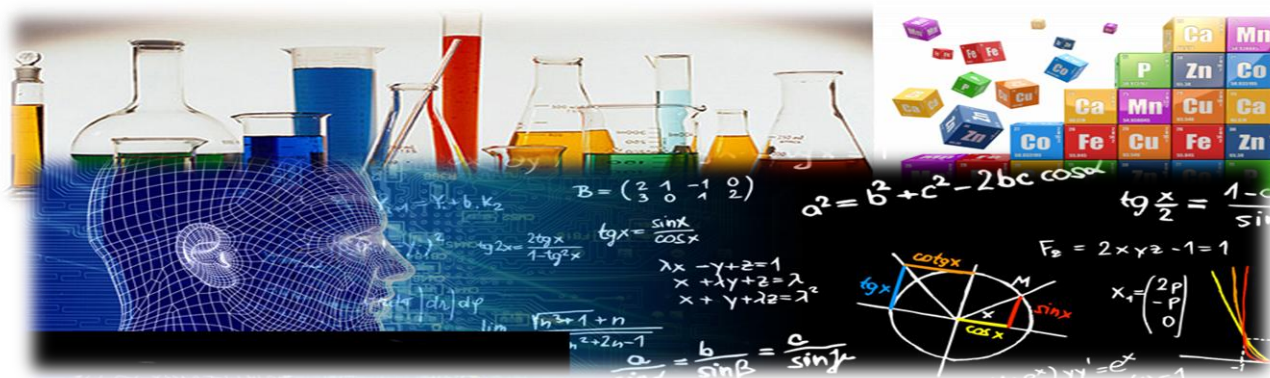

EXAMINATION PATTERN

The Council will set the question papers (Theory Part) of all the subjects for H.S. First Year Final Examination and will send the same to the nearest Police Station/Police Out Post of the examination conducting institutions for safe custody in due course of time. The question papers for the Practical Examination in subjects where practical course has been prescribed, will have to set by the institution itself. Evaluation of answer-scripts will be done by the teachers of the examination conducting institutions itself. For the subject having practical examination, the questions will be set for 70 out of a total of 100 marks by the Council. The remaining 30 marks for practical examination will be assessed by the institutions itself.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students must wear their proper uniform as prescribed by the authority in the class rooms and examination halls. No students shall be allowed to enter the class rooms and examination halls without wearing proper uniform. Boy students must have a decent hair-cut.
2. Students must carry their Identity Cards to the College regularly and produce them when asked for.
3. During Teaching hours all areas around class rooms will be observed as Silent Zone. The authority will deal with students who create any disturbance, as it deems right.
4. All students should read the Notice Board of the College regularly.
5. The monthly fee has to be paid within 10th day of every month. Non-payment of the monthly fee will impose a fine of Rs 10/- per day after 10th of the month.
6. Every student must attend 90% of the total classes. Unauthorised absent will lead to a fine of Rs 10/- per day.
7. Every student must attend all the class tests conducted by the Academy, failing which will lead to a fine of Rs. 500/- except on medical ground.
8. Students will not indulge in any anti-social activities or activities causing hindrance to the academic and administrative functioning of the College. Those found indulging in such activities will be punished and the authority will take disciplinary action against them.

9. Students will not indulge in any kind of misconduct or indiscipline inside or



outside the campus.

10. Students should strike a proper balance between extra-curricular activities and academic requirements. The extra-curricular activities of any student will not be allowed to interfere with his/her academic schedule.
11. The College Campus is a No Smoking/No Tobacco/No Drugs/No Alcohol Zone. Students found violating these instructions will be dealt with as per rules of the College.
12. Students should not damage the property of the institution. Cost of any damage will be recovered from the student.
13. Students should park their Cycles/Motor Cycles in the area allotted for the purpose.
14. Ragging in any form inside and outside the College campus is strictly prohibited by law. Any student found indulging in ragging will be dealt with as per the directives of the SUPREME COURT/HIGH COURT.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

For Science Stream: At least 60% marks obtained in HSLC/AHM Examination

For Arts Stream: At least 55% marks obtained in HSLC/AHM Examination.

Eligible candidates may apply in the prescribed forms provided by the Academy with the Prospectus for the session along with attested copies of the mark-

sheet/ certificate of the qualifying examination. Admission will be purely on merit basis. Seats are limited.

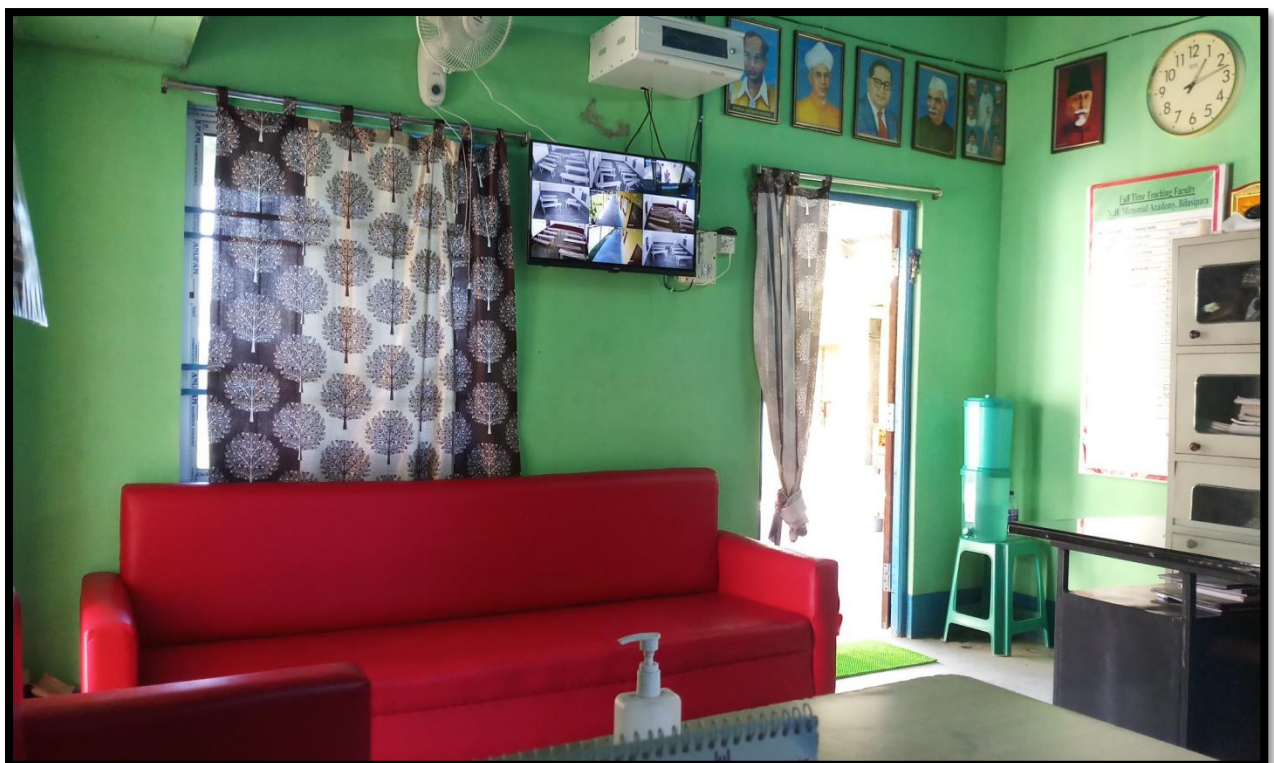


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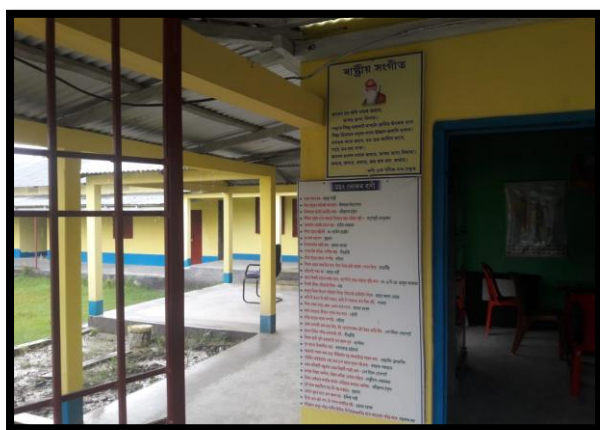
